

School Kids Program Information

The School Kids Program will provide supervision for students who are remote/e-learning during the upcoming school year. Staff will ensure that students are participating in e-learning at their designated times, provide activities during break times, and help to facilitate a safe environment for students in the program.

Program Dates

We are tentatively planning to run the program from August 24-December 18 (pending COVID-19 guidelines). We will follow the Winfield School District 34 Calendar for all Holidays from school including: Labor Day, Columbus Day, and Thanksgiving Break. We will still offer full-day childcare on Early Dismissal and Teacher Institute Days.

E-Learning Requirements

Participants must be able to follow e-learning requirements to participate in the School Kids Program. Staff will help keep children engaged while e-learning and facilitate activities during break and lunch times, but will not be considered teacher's aides or tutors. Students should bring their own headphones and devices, since grade levels and classrooms may be on different e-learning schedules throughout the week.

Participant Expectations

- Participants must be able to wear a face mask or cloth face covering during the following times:
 - Arrival/Departure
 - Hallways/Restrooms
 - Inside their program spaces when social distancing is not possible

- Participants must be able to abide by the 6ft social distancing guidelines.
 - In order to maintain 6-foot social distancing guidelines, participants must be able to do the following:
 - i. Secure their own face masks or cloth face coverings
 - ii. Be fully potty-trained and require no assistance in the restroom
 - iii. Zip jackets or hoodies without assistance
 - iv. Tie shoes without assistance
- Participants must be able to be dropped off and enter their program space without assistance from parent, guardian, or family member.
 - Only registered participants will be allowed to enter program spaces at Arrival/Departure times
- Participants will need to bring the following items to camp every day:
 - E-learning devices & headphones
 - Required materials needed to participate in e-learning (textbooks, notebooks, writing materials, etc.)
 - Reusable water bottles (water fountains are closed)
 - Face mask
 - Hoodie/sweatshirt/jacket
 - Personal hand sanitizer (if you would like)
